TO THE HONORABLE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF BERRIEN COUNTY, MICHIGAN: your County Administration Committee respectfully recommends adoption of the following:

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the Township of Buchanan (“Township”) desires to enter into an Agreement with the County of Berrien (“County”) for certain additional police protection within the Township, to be provided by the Berrien County Sheriff (“Sheriff”); and

WHEREAS, Act 35 of the Public Acts of 1951 [more specifically MCL §124.2] authorizes the County and the Township to enter into a contract regarding the performance of governmental services, including police protection; and

WHEREAS, the Sheriff has agreed to provide additional police protection for the Township for the sum of \$23,500 in connection with special police protection to be provided on and around Red Bud Track and Trail for the period of July 4 – July 7, 2019; and

WHEREAS, the Police Protection Agreement has been reviewed and approved by Corporate Counsel.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that the Berrien County Board of Commissioners authorizes the Chairman of the Board and the County Clerk to execute said Police Protection Agreement on behalf of the County and the Sheriff.
