

TO THE HONORABLE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF BERRIEN COUNTY: Your County Finance Committee respectfully recommends the adoption of the following:

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the Berrien County Board of Commissioners held a public hearing on the FY 2022 General and Special Revenue Fund Budgets, and approved said budgets on November 18, 2021; and

WHEREAS, the Berrien County Board of Commissioners, through its review by the Berrien County Equalization Department, does hereby certify that the County millages to be levied on all taxable property in Berrien County, have been reduced, if necessary, to comply with Article 9, Section 31 of the Michigan Constitution of 1963, and to comply with MCL 211.24e, 211.34, 211.34d, 211.36, and 211.37; and

WHEREAS, those reduced millage rates are set as follows: the 2022 summer levy of: 4.7680 mills - General Operating and the 2022 winter levies of: .4495 mill - 911 Service; .3496 mill - Law Enforcement; .2997 mill - Senior Citizens; and .0999 mill - Parks (PA 90); and


WHEREAS, the 2022 Taxable Value (after reduction of Renaissance Zone properties) totals \$8,873,232,340 and using the approved millage rates reflects the following estimated County revenues:



Senior Citizens	.2997 mill X \$8,873,232,340 =	\$2,659,307.73
Parks (PA 90)	.0999 mill X \$8,873,232,340 =	<u>\$886,435.91</u>

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Equalization Department will submit the approved rates to the State of Michigan on behalf of the Berrien County Board of Commissioners.
