New for the 2010-2011 School Year:

Students 11-18 years of age who are changing school districts OR will be enrolling in the 6th grade are required to have:

One dose of Meningitis (MCV4) vaccine
One dose of Tetanus/Diphtheria/Pertussis (Tdap) vaccine
Two doses of Varicella (Chickenpox) vaccine or history of chickenpox disease

All students entering kindergarten OR changing school districts are required to have:

Two doses of Varicella (Chickenpox) vaccine or history of chickenpox disease

The Berrien County Health Department is hosting three Super Saturday Clinics to help you get your child vaccinated at a reduced cost!
